Altadena Library Foundation INTERNSHIP INFORMATION

Eligibility: A candidate must be an undergraduate college student enrolled with a University for Fall 2024. .

General Information: One Internship is offered only during the period of May 15-August 31, 2024. This program serves as an opportunity to work within the community, serve the Altadena Libraries and contribute to the mission of the Altadena Library Foundation. About 50% of the work will also include working with the Altadena Rotary Club helping digitize their historical items and other related tasks. It is anticipated that the Intern will also have the opportunity to meet one on one with staff members of the local elected officials that represent the Altadena Community. Some work with social media might also be included.

Intern will **not** receive academic credit. However, Intern will be paid \$17 per hour. It is anticipated that the Intern can work up to 200 hours for the 10 week program.
